2. Homeless Programs and Services Update (Phoenix Rescue Mission and Community House)

Jackie Parks, Executive Director for Community House, will present on the services provided by the Day Relief Center and Community House.

Lt. Kevin Quon from Scottsdale Police Department will provide information on PD contacts and direction regarding Homelessness.
