Public Comment – Non-Agendized Items

Arizona State law prohibits Neighborhood Advisory Commission from discussing or taking action on an item that is not on the prepared agenda. Speakers may complete one Request to Speak "Public Comment" card per meeting to address the members of the Neighborhood Advisory Commission. Public testimony is limited to three (3) minutes per speaker and a total of 15 minutes.
