Public Comment

Arizona State law prohibits the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee from discussing or taking action on an item that is not on the prepared agenda. Citizens may complete one Request to Speak "Public Comment" card per meeting and submit it to City Staff. **Public testimony is limited to three (3) minutes per speaker.**

Written comment cards are accepted for both agendized and non-agendized items and may be submitted to City Staff at any time. Cards submitted after public testimony has begun will be provided to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee at the conclusion of the testimony for that item.

The Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee cannot discuss or vote on items not on the Agenda, including items brought up as public comments. If action by the Committee is needed, the items should be placed on the next meeting's agenda to be consistent with the Arizona Open Meeting Law.
