1. Request for Executive Session to:

A. Discuss and consult with the City's attorneys for legal advice; discuss and consult with designated representatives of the City to consider its position and to instruct its representatives regarding negotiations for the purchase, sale, or lease of real property; and discuss and consult with the City's attorneys to consider the City's position and instruct its attorneys regarding contracts that are the subject of negotiations. These matters all pertain to real property located near the following locations in Scottsdale, Arizona:

1. Legacy and 74th Street Alignment

2. Bell Road Corridor and WestWorld

a. West of intersection Thompson Peak Parkway and McDowell Mountain Ranch Road

b. 96th Street and Bell Road

A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3), (4) & (7).

B. Discuss and consult with the City's attorneys and other designated representatives of the City for legal advice in order to consider the City's position as a result of the of the passage of the Smart and Safe Arizona Act (Proposition 207) legalizing recreational marijuana in Arizona, but allowing the City to impose various recreational marijuana regulations, and for legal advice regarding proposed Ordinance No. 4484 adding Chapter 25 to the Scottsdale Revised Code further regulating recreational marijuana within the City in accordance with A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(3).

– Councilwoman Littlefield made a motion to adjourn into executive session. Councilwoman Korte seconded the motion, which carried 6/0, with Vice Mayor Whitehead and Councilmembers Klapp, Korte, Littlefield, Milhaven, and Phillips voting in the affirmative.
