BACKGROUND

The DC Ranch Community Facilities District (District) was formed in 1997 to facilitate the financing, acquisition, and construction of public infrastructure within the District. To date, \$20,000,000 of tax-exempt bonds have been issued.

The District is responsible for the installation and maintenance of infrastructure, which benefits existing and future residents of the District and the City. An ongoing tax assessment is necessary to pay the debt service on the District's bonds and the District's operation and maintenance expenses.

The FY 2024/25 proposed budget (see Exhibit A of Attachment #1) has been prepared pursuant to the requirements of the Arizona Revised Statutes. The District considers anticipated administrative costs and uncollectable accounts, and may reduce cash balances as needed to comply with Arizona Revised Statutes § 48-719(D). The first Resolution calls for approval of the proposed budget and provides for other statutory requirements related to the proposed budget, including calling for a public hearing on the proposed budget. Immediately following adoption of the first Resolution, the District will conduct a public hearing on the proposed budget and receive public comment. Approving the second Resolution will adopt the final budget subsequent to the hearing (see Exhibit B of Attachment #2) and set the tax levy for the District.

The District is impacted by a court case and judgment arising out of a class action lawsuit (*Qasimyar v. Maricopa County*), that will reduce the FY 2024/25 property tax revenues coming to the District by approximately \$300,905 (according to Maricopa County's estimate, plus interest) in order to provide tax refunds to certain taxpayers.

Additionally, the District has a separate Dedication Easement and Maintenance Agreement with the Developer, DC Ranch HOA (DC Ranch Community Council) and the city where the District agreed to maintain, repair and replace certain Easements Areas and Public Infrastructure in accordance with Approved Maintenance Standards as defined in the Second Supplement to the Easement and Maintenance Agreement. The District levies additional operation and maintenance tax (O&M tax) and transfers funds annually to the HOA to meet such requirements

under the Maintenance Agreement (note that the Maintenance Agreement does not require the District to assess an O&M tax nor does it require the District to transfer funds to the HOA). The O&M tax levied by the District includes approximately \$61,000 each year for maintenance under the Maintenance Agreement. The DC Ranch Community Council, who represents the DC Ranch community, approached the District with a request to increase the O&M tax to pay for increased costs of maintenance/landscaping of paths and trails within the community. The amount included in the O&M tax for maintenance/landscaping has been relatively consistent at \$61,000 since 2013. The DC Ranch Community Council is requesting an additional \$261,381 for a total of \$322,381 to be included in the FY 2024/25 property tax levy. A phased-in approach for the \$322,381 is also proposed as Option 3 for consideration and is acceptable to the DC Ranch Community Council provided that the additional costs not levied in FY24/25 are recovered in future years.

FISCAL IMPACT FOR FY24/25

Levy for Debt - The District will levy an *ad valorem* tax of \$1,592,584 on District property for debt service which includes an additional \$300,905 needed for the Qasimyar vs Maricopa County class action lawsuit judgment. Information about this class action lawsuit can be found on the Maricopa County Assessor's website at https://mcassessor.maricopa.gov/page/home/qasimyar.

Levy for Maintenance and Operation - In addition to the levy for debt service, the District will levy one of the following Options on District property for maintenance and operation:

Option 1 – Levy \$79,882 to provide \$61,000 for maintenance of paths and trails and \$18,882 for administrative costs, reserves and delinquency allowance.

Option 2 – Levy \$348,042 to provide \$322,381 for maintenance of paths and trails and \$25,661 for administrative costs, reserves and delinquency allowance.

Option 3 – Levy \$128,746 to provide \$107,000 for maintenance of paths and trails and \$21,746 for administrative costs, reserves and delinquency allowance.

The District cannot levy for more than the adopted budget, i.e. if Resolution No. 61, Option 1 approving the lower budget is adopted, then Resolution No. 62, Option 1 adopting the lower levy must be adopted, and Resolution No. 62 Option 2 adopting a higher levy cannot be adopted.

IMPACT ON PROPERTY TAXES

Option 1 - The estimated tax rate per \$100.00 of net assessed limited property value is \$0.3897 if the operations and maintenance costs remain at \$61,000. Property taxes on a typical property with a \$1.3M limited property assessed value would increase by approximately 24% from the prior year.

Option 2 – The estimated tax rate per \$100.00 of net assessed limited property value is \$0.4522 if the full requested increase of \$322,381 in maintenance and landscaping costs are included. Property taxes on a typical property with a \$1.3M limited property assessed value would increase by approximately 44% from the prior year.

Option 3 – The estimated tax rate per \$100 of net assessed limited property value is \$0.4011 if \$107,000 is assessed for maintenance and landscaping costs. Property taxes on a typical property with a \$1.3M limited property assessed value would increase by approximately 28% from the prior year.



- 2. Tax Levy. A tax levy (the "Tax Levy") in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C is hereby ordered, approved, and adopted, and the District Clerk is hereby directed to deliver certified copies of the Tax Levy to the Maricopa County (Arizona) Board of Supervisors, to the Arizona Department of Revenue, and to any entity acting as trustee for any District bonds.
 - 3. *Effective Date*. This Resolution is effective immediately.
