**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Lisa Borowsky called to order a Special Meeting of the Scottsdale City Council at 3:03 P.M. on Tuesday, June 16, 2026 in the City Hall Kiva Forum.

**ROLL CALL**

Mayor Borowsky asked City Clerk Ben Lane to conduct the roll call.

Mayor Borowsky reconvened the Special Meeting (following Executive Session) at 5:05 P.M. noting that all Councilmembers were present and all Charter Officers were in attendance.

1. **Charter Officer Evaluations**

a. **Acting City Auditor**

**Request:** Discuss, consider, and take possible action regarding the Acting City Auditor's compensation and benefits, assignment, and/or appointment.

**MOTION AND VOTE – ITEM 1A**

Vice Mayor McAllen made a motion to approve a temporary pay increase for the Acting City Auditor to a new base salary of \$192,416.64 to be effective and retroactive, to the beginning of the June 14, 2026 pay period. This pay increase will continue until such time as a permanent City Auditor is appointed and begins employment. Councilwoman Littlefield seconded the motion, which carried 7/0, with Mayor Borowsky; Vice Mayor McAllen; and Councilmembers Dubauskas, Graham, Kwasman, Littlefield, and Whitehead voting in the affirmative.

b. **City Manager**

**Request:** Discuss, consider, and take possible action regarding the employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, compensation and benefits, disciplining, and/or resignation of the City Manager.

**MOTION AND VOTE – ITEM 1B**

Vice Mayor McAllen made a motion to continue the City Manager's contract at a base salary of \$400,000 to be effective and retroactive, to the beginning of the June 14, 2026 pay period. Councilman Kwasman seconded the motion, which carried 5/2, with Mayor Borowsky and Councilmembers Dubauskas, Graham, Kwasman, and Littlefield voting in the affirmative and Vice Mayor McAllen and Councilwoman Whitehead dissenting.

c. **City Treasurer**

**Request:** Discuss, consider, and take possible action regarding the employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, compensation and benefits, disciplining, and/or resignation of the City Treasurer.

**MOTION AND VOTE – ITEM 1C**

Vice Mayor McAllen made a motion to continue the City Treasurer's contract at a base salary of \$291,209.98 to be effective and retroactive, to the beginning of the June 14, 2026 pay period. Councilman Kwasman seconded the motion, which carried 7/0, with Mayor Borowsky; Vice Mayor McAllen; and Councilmembers Dubauskas, Graham, Kwasman, Littlefield, and Whitehead voting in the affirmative.

d. **City Clerk**

**Request:** Discuss, consider, and take possible action regarding the employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, demotion, dismissal, compensation and benefits, disciplining, and/or resignation of the City Clerk.

**MOTION AND VOTE – ITEM 1D**

Vice Mayor McAllen made a motion to continue the City Clerk's contract at a base salary of \$239,206.66 to be effective and retroactive, to the beginning of the June 14, 2026 pay period. Councilman Kwasman seconded the motion, which carried 7/0, with Mayor Borowsky; Vice Mayor McAllen; and Councilmembers Dubauskas, Graham, Kwasman, Littlefield, and Whitehead voting in the affirmative.

**MOTION AND VOTE – ADJOURNMENT**

Mayor Borowsky made a motion to adjourn the Special Meeting. Councilwoman Whitehead seconded the motion, which carried 7/0, by voice vote, with Mayor Borowsky; Vice Mayor McAllen; and Councilmembers Dubauskas, Graham, Kwasman, Littlefield, and Whitehead voting in the affirmative.

**ADJOURNMENT**

The Special Meeting adjourned at 5:09 P.M.
