Vice Mayor McAllen: So moved.

Councilwoman Littlefield: Second.

Mayor Borowsky: Thank you. Please indicate your vote. We are recessed into Executive Session. Thank you.

RECESS INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION

RECONVENE SPECIAL MEETING

Mayor Borowsky: We're back, we completed our Executive Session and I'm reconvening the Special Council Meeting. For the record, all Councilmembers and the Charter Officers are all in attendance and we will proceed with the motions related to the Charter Officers.

And with that, do I have a motion related to the Acting City Auditor from the Vice Mayor?

Vice Mayor McAllen: Thank you, Mayor. I move that we approve a temporary pay increase for the oh, I'm sorry. I move that we approve a pay increase for the Acting City Auditor to the base salary of \$192,416.64 to be effective and retroactive to the beginning of June 14, 2016 pay period. This pay increase will continue until such time as a permanent City Auditor is appointed and begins employment.

Mayor Borowsky: All right. All those in favor, please indicate your vote. Okay. And I would like a motion now from the Vice Mayor related to the City Manager's contract.

Vice Mayor McAllen: I move to continue the City Manager's contract at a base salary of \$400,000, to be effective and retroactive to the beginning of June 14, 2026 pay period.

Councilman Kwasman: Second.

Mayor Borowsky: Okay. Before I call for a vote, I would like to speak to that briefly. I'm supporting this motion because there was consensus to do even more of an increase, and as a result of the

compromise, which I am in favor of, I am supporting this motion. So if no one else has any questions, I will ask for a vote.

Next, we have the City Treasurer's contract, and Vice Mayor, do you have a motion?

Vice Mayor McAllen: Yes. I move to continue the City Treasurer's contract at a base salary of \$291,209.98, to be effective and retroactive to the beginning of June 14, 2026 pay period.

Councilman Kwasman: Second.

Mayor Borowsky: All those well, please indicate your vote. Okay. And finally, we have the motion related to the City Clerk's contract, and I will ask the Vice Mayor to make a motion on this one.

Vice Mayor McAllen: I move to continue the City Clerk's contract at a base salary of \$239,206.66, to be effective and retroactive to the beginning of the pay period of June 14, 2026.

Mayor Borowsky: Okay. Please indicate your vote. Oh, we need a second.

Councilman Kwasman: Second.

Councilwoman Littlefield: Second.

Mayor Borowsky: Okay. All right. That concludes our Special Meeting, and with that, I will move to adjourn.

Councilwoman Whitehead: Second.

Mayor Borowsky: Thank you. We are adjourned.
