

Pinnacle Peak Park Trail

Park hours vary through the year and are on the park website. Entering or remaining in the park during closed hours is strictly prohibited.

Trail Notes:

- Distance: 2 miles one way
- No restroom or water available on the trail
- The brown (PK) markers 6-8 inches tall along the trail represent 100-foot distances for guiding emergency services.

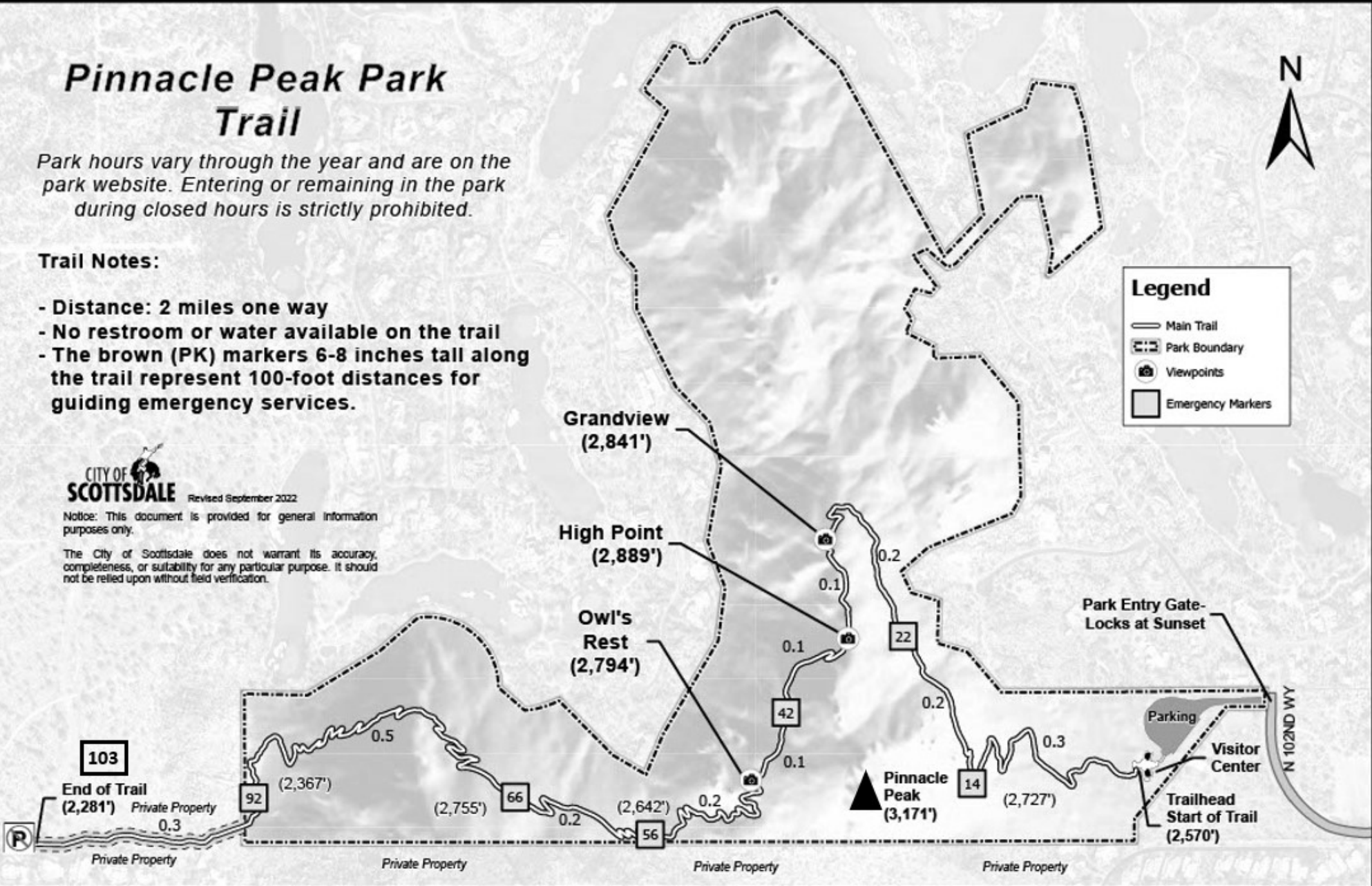

For a safe and enjoyable visit please consider the following:

- Carry sufficient water while hiking (when its half gone turn around).
- Be aware of weather conditions such as thunderstorms and excessive heat.
- Stay to the right while on the trail.
- Uphill travelers have the right-of-way.
- No restrooms or water available on the trail

Rules and Regulations:

- No dogs allowed on the trail
- No amplified music (earbud and headphones are welcome)
- No drones
- Stay on the designated trail. No off-trail hiking
